



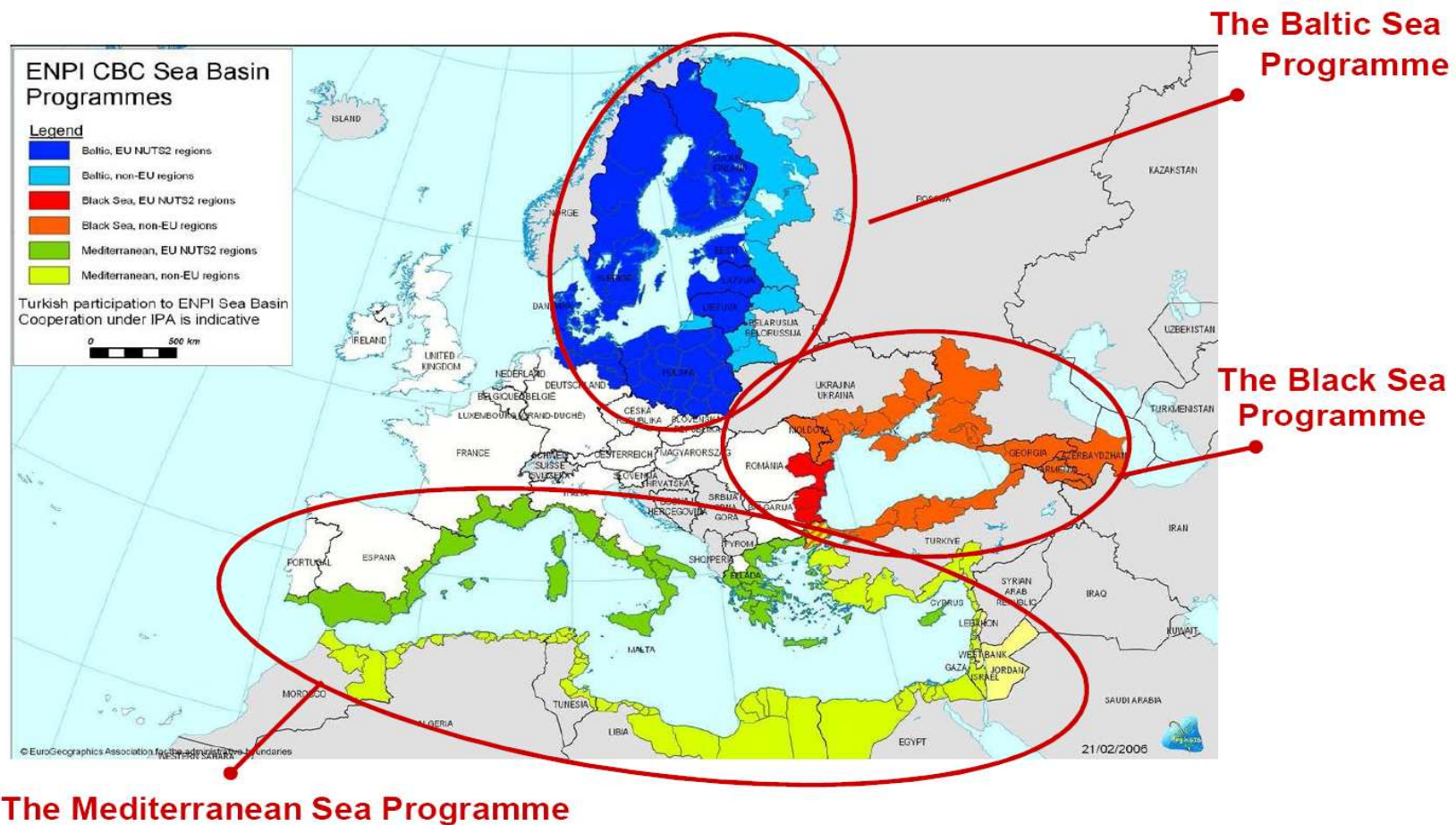

ENPI CBC MED Programme Briefing

- Aims:
 - Avoiding the emergency of new dividing lines between the enlarged EU and neighboring countries
 - Creating at the EU borders an area of economic prosperity, as well as stability and security
- EU co-financing = 90%
- Partnership (standard projects) = minimum of 3 countries of which at least one EU Mediterranean country and one Mediterranean partner country within the programme eligible areas
- Application submission deadline: **20th October 2009**

Priority 1: Promotion of socio-economic development and enhancement of territories



Priority 3: Promotion of better conditions and modalities for ensuring the mobility of persons, goods and capitals



Priority 1

Promotion of socio-economic development and enhancement of Territories

- EUR 68,748,500 (40%)

Measure1.1. Support to innovation and research in the process of local development of the Mediterranean Sea Basin countries

Examples of possible actions:

- *Joint actions of research in the framework of production sectors, research centres,*
- *Networking of innovation and technology-transfer centres for the elaboration of joint projects.*

Measure1.2. Strengthening economic clusters creating synergies among potentials of the Mediterranean Sea Basin countries

Examples of possible actions :

- *Joint strategies and services for the development of trans-mediterranean economic clusters (agro-industrial, textile, tourism, etc.);*
- *Strengthening cooperation among professional organisations in order to reinforce the competitiveness of the various production sectors.*

Priority 1

Promotion of socio-economic development and enhancement of Territories

- EUR 68,748,500 (40%)

Measure1.3. Strengthening the national strategies of territorial planning by integrating the different levels, and promotion of balanced and sustainable socioeconomic development

Examples of possible actions :

- Cooperation between institutions in charge of territorial planning (transports,coasts/inland, social and educational services).

Priority 2

Promotion of environmental sustainability at the basin level

EUR 51,561,375 (30%)

Measure 2.1 Prevention and reduction of risk factors for the environment and enhancement of natural common heritage

Examples of actions:

- *Support for the conservation and enhancement of the maritime heritage by adopting transnational joint monitoring systems*
- *Support for the creation of networks among the Mediterranean's natural parks and protected areas for sustainable tourism purposes*
- *Development of good practices, mainly through the exchange of experiences, in the management of coastal area, in combating coastal over-exploitation, beach degradation, in preventing and reducing the pollution of natural resources*

Priority 2

Promotion of environmental sustainability at the basin level

EUR 51,561,375 (30%)

Measure 2.2 Promotion of renewable energy and improvement of energy efficiency contributing to addressing, among other challenges, climate change

Examples of actions:

- *Development of joint activities to spread the use of renewable energies (solar, photovoltaic, wind, geothermal) and energy efficiency in the public and private sectors*
- *Conducting joint awareness and mobilizing campaigns for people on common challenges related to the cooperation area and on the rational use of energy resources*

Priority 3

Promotion of better conditions and modalities for ensuring the mobility of persons, goods and capitals

EUR 17,187,125

Measure 3.1. Support to people flows among territories as a means of cultural, social and economic enrichment

Examples of possible actions :

- *Joint structures for observing migration flows;*
- *Promoting information, education and awareness raising campaigns on migration and immigrants' rights, addressed to different target groups.*

Measure 3.2. Improvement of conditions and modalities of circulation of goods and capitals among the territories

Examples of possible actions :

- *Training activities for operators (productive sectors and public administrations) especially in relation to quality standards and health controls (agrofood);*
- *Strengthening the links and the networking among Mediterranean ports especially through the utilisation of ICT applied to sea transport and port operations.*

Priority 4

Promotion of cultural dialogue and local governance

EUR 34,374,250 (20%)

Measure 4.1 Support to mobility, exchanges, training and professionalism of young people

Examples of actions:

- *Promotion of cultural cooperation and exchange activities for young people (primary and secondary schools and universities) including training for teachers, educators and operators of local associations*
- *Setting up platforms of dialogue among and through young people about issues related to the pan-Mediterranean culture, to be organised by students in order to support the understanding process among people*
- *Joint development of modalities for supporting employment among young people, including placement in companies for young people*

Priority 4

Promotion of cultural dialogue and local governance

EUR 34,374,250 (20%)

Measure 4.2 Support to the artistic creativity in all its expressions to encourage dialogue among communities

Examples of actions:

- *Support for cooperation in the audio-visual and media sectors, through the joint production of documentaries, short films, TV programmes, books ... etc*
- *Spreading knowledge of Mediterranean cultures through the use of new technologies, including digitalisation and distribution of cultural and scientific material*
- *Promoting dialogue through initiatives of intercultural exchange among young emerging artists (painters, musicians, writers, actors) and artistic cross-fertilisation*

The Beneficiary (Lead Partner)

It is responsible for the management, implementation and coordination of the activities among the partners involved, and it is legally responsible for the partnership


- It submits the project proposal
- If the project is selected, it **signs the Grant Agreement** with the Joint Managing Authority.
- It submits the **payment requests, receives payments** and ensures the allocation of resources to the other partners.
- It is responsible for the content of the **activity, financial and audit reports** and for their submission to the Joint Managing Authority.
- It is responsible for the **recovery of unjustified or ineligible expenditure** and for its reimbursement to the Joint Managing Authority.

The Partners

They play an active role in the development and implementation of the project activities, together with the Lead Partner

- They implement the **project activities** for which they are responsible.
- They **provide the Lead Partner the necessary information** concerning the payment requests and ensure that their expenditures are certified by an auditor.
- They prepare their part of the **activity, financial and audit reports** and submit them to the Lead Partner.







Description: The project foresees the experimentation of the Regeneration Policy as a strategy for local development, leveraging on the potentials and local characteristics, such as elements of strength and range of business opportunities in rural areas. The Project is focused on building a network and an Internet platform on which to promote the Local Activities Offer Plan to improve the accessibility and attractiveness of the most internal and depopulated and facilitate the arrival of new investment and new residents, that will create new business for the revitalization of social and economic development of territories. Strong involvement of all stakeholders, government, businesses and local people. The project is also oriented testing of joint actions between the coastal areas and the more fragile internal, joint actions to build and promote a more coherent and integrated.

Main objectives: The overall objective of the project is to innovate the governance and development policies in the Mediterranean, with the sharing of a strategy aimed at rural renewal as a whole, through the adoption of specific tools and the fight against depopulation and impoverishment social and economic aspects of the most marginal and vulnerable.

Set up a strong communication campaign by television, satellite, digital, offers job listings, etc.. to attract new residents and investment in rural and mountainous areas 4. increase education and training to the public and local businesses 5. promote a strong involvement of the people and businesses to the issues of regeneration policy and the strategies proposed 6. establish a strong link with the European experience 7. testing of a fair of the regeneration policy with the involvement of rural fairs organizations 8. Propose new Projects consistent and complementary with different funding lines like for instance the ERDF PSR
