### **EUROPE FOR CITIZENS 2007-2013: SEMINAR FOR LOCAL COUNCILS AND NGOS**

The *Malta-EU Steering and Action Committee* (MEUSAC) is organising a half-day seminar which will focus entirely on the European Union's funding programme *Europe for Citizens 2007-2013*.

This Seminar is one in a series of funding-related initiatives being undertaken by MEUSAC and will be held on **Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> October 2008** at the **Victoria Hotel, Sliema** at **8.45am**.

The *Europe for Citizens* programme is an important tool intended to support the European Commission's Plan D project to strengthen dialogue, debate and democracy in Europe. In this context, the programme seeks to give the citizen a key role in the development of the European Union, by promoting Europe's common values and history, fostering a sense of ownership of the EU project among citizens.. In more concrete terms, the programme's priority areas are: the promotion of participation and democracy at EU level; the future of the Union and its basic values; intercultural dialogue; employment, social cohesion and sustainable development; and boosting awareness of the societal impact of EU policies. It focuses on four action areas namely *Active citizens for Europe, Active civil society in Europe, Together for Europe and Active European remembrance..*

The programme will run for a period of seven years (2007–2013) and the overall budget allocated for this period is of €215 million. Action 1, to which approximately 45% of the programme's budget – equivalent to around €96 million – is allocated, targets town-twinning initiatives and citizens' projects.

The Seminar will focus mainly on Action 1 which seeks to encourage citizens to play a more active role both locally and at EU level. This Action seeks to bring together people from local communities across Europe through town-twinning, in order to promote mutual understanding, learning about other cultures in Europe and the emergence of a European identity to complement local and regional ones.

The main speaker will be Natasha Jovicic, from the Citizenship Unit P7 at the Education Audiovisual & Culture Executive Agency. She will review the calls for proposals under Action 1, focusing on Action 1.1 (Town twinning citizens' meetings) and Action 1.2 (The thematic networking of twinned towns), and will also provide participants with guidance on the Programme's application and selection process.

Silvio Frendo (Assistant Director – Policy & Planning, Department for Local Government) will outline the role of the Department for Local Government in this process. San Lawrenz Local Council Mayor Noel Formosa will be sharing his experience on a project funded through the Active European Citizenship 2004-2006 programme, the predecessor of the *Europe for Citizens* programme.

The seminar targets mainly **local councils** and **non-government organisations**.

Dr Gabriella Pace, MEUSAC's Head of Information, will be chairing this Seminar. The Hon. Chris Said, Parliamentary Secretary for Public Dialogue and Information, will be delivering the opening address, while the closing address will be delivered by Dr Vanni Xuereb, Head of MEUSAC.

Participation is free of charge, but prior registration is required in view of seating restrictions. Registrations should reach Brian Pace at MEUSAC by not later than noon of Monday 27<sup>th</sup> October on [funding.meusac@gov.mt](mailto:funding.meusac@gov.mt).

Dan il-programm gie allokati baġit ta' €215 miljun għall-perjodu 2007-2013. Madwar €96 miljun, jiġifieri 45% tat-total allokati għall-programm, se jintefqu fuq l-ewwel azzjoni.

Is-Seminar se jkun qed jindirizza l-ewwel azzjoni ta' dan il-programm: 'Ċittadini Attivi għall-Ewropa'. Din l-azzjoni tindirizza b'mod speċifiku attivitajiet li jinvolvu liċ-ċittadini, fosthom il-partecipazzjoni tagħhom f'gemellaġġi ta' bliet, kif ukoll it-tkattir ta' proġetti fejn iċ-ċittadini jipparteċipaw f'dibattitu li jsaħħah id-diversità kulturali.
