MEUSAC ISSUES CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST BY CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANISATIONS

The Malta-EU Steering and Action Committee (MEUSAC) is requesting Civil Society Organisations to express their interest to participate in the MEUSAC consultation process on the formulation of EU legislation. As part of this process MEUSAC is establishing nine Sectoral Committees dealing with: General Affairs; Economic and Financial Affairs; Justice and Home Affairs; Employment, Social Policy and Health; Competitiveness and Consumer Affairs; Transport, Telecommunications and Energy; Agriculture and Fisheries, Environment; and Education, Culture and Youth. These Committees, widely shadowing the EU Council formations, will be composed of representatives of the Government and government entities, Core Group members and Civil Society Organisations operating within the area of responsibility of that particular Committee.

The Committees will provide a forum for the analysis of legislative proposals, discussion among parties and the gathering of reactions for the use of relevant public officials. This is an

opportunity for civil society to participate in the formulation of Malta's position on legislative developments in the European Union.

By means of the Sectoral Committees and the Core Group, MEUSAC seeks to manage a consultation process that attempts to engage the social partners as well as civil society in the EU decision-making process. The Core Group, chaired by the Parliamentary Secretary for Public Dialogue and Information, includes representatives of Government, constituted bodies, political parties, civil society and independent experts.

Civil Society Organisations are invited to express their interest in participating in the initial stages of the consultation process on European legislation. The eligibility criteria for the participation of Civil Society Organisations in the Sectoral Committees were agreed upon by the Core Group last September.

Application forms as well as the eligibility criteria may be downloaded from the MEUSAC website: www.meusac.gov.mt. Duly filled applications are to be submitted at the MEUSAC offices, at 280, Republic Street, Valletta by **Friday 12 December 2008**. Such application may also be submitted by email on consult.meusac@gov.mt. Civil Society Organisations should clearly indicate which Sectoral Committee they would like to contribute to when compiling their application.

Il-Kumitati se jagħtu spazju għall-forum li janalizza l-proposti legiſlattivi, jqajjem diskussjoni bejn il-partijiet ikkonċernati u jiġbor reazzjonijiet għall-użu ta' uffiċjali pubbliċi rilevanti. Din hija opportunità għas-soċjetà ċivili biex tipparteċipa fil-formulazzjoni tal-pożizzjoni Maltija dwar żviluppi legiſlattivi fi ħdan l-Unjoni Ewropea.
