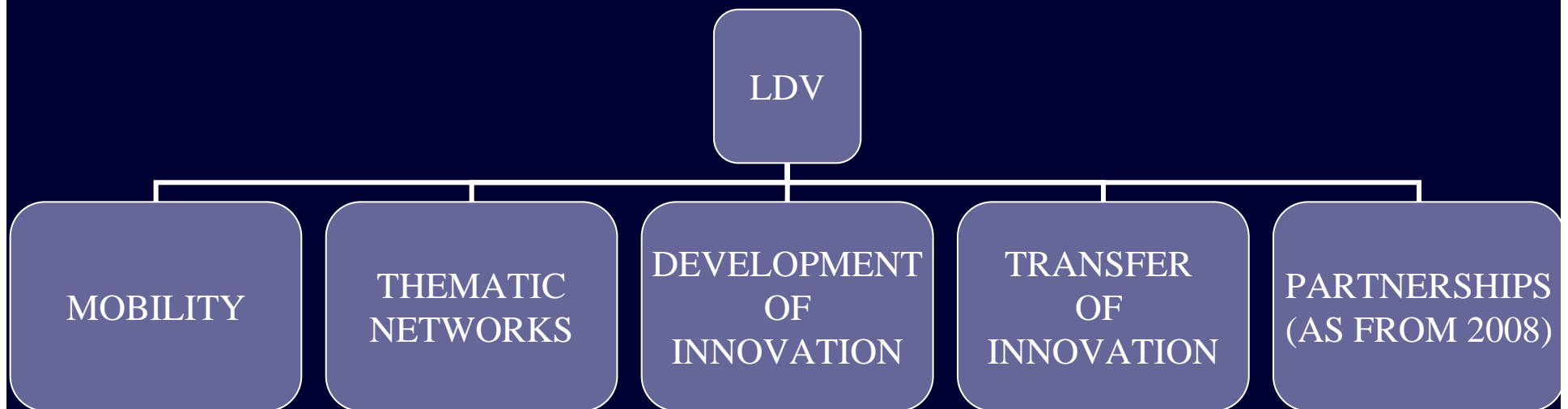

The Leonardo Da Vinci Programme

- The 3 main objectives
 - To support participants in training
 - To support improvement in quality and innovation
 - Enhance vocational education and training (V.E.T.) and mobility

LDV – IMPLEMENTATION OF OBJECTIVES

- Importance given to proposals featuring:
 - Development of practices to facilitate access to training for people most at a disadvantage in the labour market, including physically challenged.
 - Equal opportunities for women and men, with the view to combating discrimination in training provision.

LDV - EMPHASIS

- Special accreditation will be given to projects:
 - Facilitating participation by small organisations, micro enterprises and SMEs
 - Vocational Oriented Language Learning
 - Content integrated Language Learning
 - Multiplier effect

LDV – Mobility – Actions and Target Groups

LDV – APPLICATION FOR MOBILITY PROJECT

- ❑ Applicant countries have to be from the eligible countries i.e. the 27 Members States, the EFTA Countries and Turkey
- ❑ Submitted by a legal body / institutions and signed by the legally authorised person (Declaration of honour)
- ❑ Comply with the deadlines set in the call for proposals

LDV – APPLICATION FOR MOBILITY PROJECT

- Use the official EC application form
- The application form must be written in one of the official EU Languages. If the application is not written in English, German or French, it should include a summary in any of the above three languages

LDV – APPLICATION FOR MOBILITY PROJECT

- The application should include **Original letters of intent** from the mandatory minimum numbers of partners, printed on an official letter-head carrying the signature of the legally authorised person of that organisation

LDV – APPLICATION FOR MOBILITY PROJECT

- ❑ December 2007 Call to be published by EC
- ❑ Jan-Feb 2008 Seminars / Workshops
- ❑ Feb-Mar 2008 (t.b.c) LdV Application deadline
- ❑ April-May 2008 Evaluation and Selection
- ❑ June 2008 Results Published
- ❑ July 2008 Project Start Date

LDV – Multilateral Projects

- Transfer of Innovation: identifying one innovative solution and adapting it to the target countries
(Decentralised Measure)
- Development of Innovation: developing a brand new solution to help several countries to cope with a common challenge which is not yet addressed
(Centralised Measure)

LDV – Multilateral Projects

- Aims for Transfer and Development of Innovation
 - Quality of VET systems and practices
 - Teachers and Trainers in VET
 - Innovative e-learning content
 - European credit transfer system of VET
 - Validation of non-formal and informal learning
