MEUSAC-PPCD Seminar on EU Territorial Cooperation Programmes

The *Malta-EU Steering and Action Committee* (MEUSAC), in collaboration with the Planning and Priorities Coordination Division of the Office of the Prime Minister (PPCD), today organised a half-day seminar on Territorial Cooperation Opportunities aimed at local councils. In fact, this is one in a series of information seminars which are being organised specifically for local councils.

In his opening address, MEUSAC Head Dr Vanni Xuereb said that MEUSAC is doing its utmost to ensure the best possible assistance to local councils both through the dissemination of information on funding opportunities as well through practical assistance including that relating to project applications. Dr Xuereb reiterated that MEUSAC is strengthening its structure by recruiting more staff within the Information Unit and the Funding Unit so as to ensure that local councils, civil society organisations as well as the general public are well served. He stated that another important tool within MEUSAC and which should benefit local councils is the consultation process on proposed EU legislation. Dr Xuereb encouraged councillors to sound their views through the Local Council Association on the position to be taken by Government in the Council of Ministers.

Dr. Gabriella Pace, Head of the Information Unit within MEUSAC emphasised the importance of disseminating information on EU funding programmes. She encouraged local councils to work together in order for their localities to benefit more from such programmes.

Mr. Stephen Calleja, Director (*Programmes and Projects*) within the PPCD, introduced the Unit responsible for the European Territorial Cooperation Objective of the Structural Funds. Mr Calleja noted the interest registered by local councils in participating in projects funded by the 2004-2006 financial programme. He encouraged local councils to keep the national priorities in mind when submitting project applications.

Programmes on Territorial Cooperation Opportunities aim at encouraging the exchange, sharing and transfer of policy experience, knowledge and good practices by European regions and cities. PPCD officials delivered in-depth presentations on the various programmes and explained available funding possibilities for local councils willing to submit project proposals under these programmes.

Projects submitted under the Programmes on Territorial Cooperation Opportunities are 85% co-financed by the Structural Funds. The remaining 15% is to be forked by the local councils.

Ms. Maria Schembri, Head of the Funding Unit within MEUSAC, explained the tailor-made services which MEUSAC offers to local councils.

Participants had the opportunity to listen to experiences of local councils which have benefited under previous programmes. ***Cultexchange*** is a project conducted by the Mosta Local Council and its Sicilian partner. The aim of the project was the restoration of two Paleo-Christian catacombs. ***Medcypre***, a project conducted by 15 partners, of which the Imgarr Local Council, led to the planting of 2500 cypress trees in two localities in Imgarr. As part of the project studies were conducted to determine the soil formation in the areas where the trees were planted. The **Cospicua Local Council** conducted a project titled **CSM/Emedit** whose aim was to advertise small historic centres, their products and traditions. **Medcoasnet**, a project conducted by the **Vittoriosa Local Council** and the **Fondazzjoni Temi Zammit**, together with partners from other European Union member states, to create a permanent network of authorities and agencies involved in the sustainable management of coastal urban Mediterranean zones.

While delivering the closing address, the Parliamentary Secretary for Public Dialogue and Information, Dr. Chris Said, stated that practical assistance to local councils and dissemination of information on EU funding opportunities is being given great importance by the Government to ensure that local councils maximise on the opportunities offered by EU funding programmes. This will be further strengthened by means of a co-financing fund which is to be launched this coming Wednesday.

Il-MEUSAC u l-PPCD jorganizzaw Seminar dwar il-Programmi ta' Kooperazzjoni Territorjali Ewropea

Il-Malta-EU Steering and Action Committee (MEUSAC), b' kollaborazzjoni mad-Divizjoni għall-Ippjanar u Koordinazzjoni tal-Prioritajiet (PPCD) fl-Uffiċċju tal-Prim Minitru, illum organizza laqgħa oħra ta' informazzjoni għall-kunsilli lokali dwar il-Programmi ta' Kooperazzjoni Territorjali Ewropea. Fil-fatt din il-laqgħa hija waħda minn sensiela ta' inizjattivi informattivi li qed jiġu organizzati speċifikament għall-benefiċċju tal-kunsilli lokali.

Fl-indirizz tiegħu, il-Kap tal-MEUSAC, Dott. Kooperazzjoni Territorjali Ewropea. Is-Sur Calleja semma l-interess tal-kunsilli lokali biex jipparteċipaw fi proġetti ffinanzjati mill-programmi li tagħhom hija responsabbli din it-taqsimha tant li taħt il-Programm 2004 - 2006 saru madwar 56 proġett. Huwa heġġeġ lill-kunsilli lokali jaqraw tajjeb id-dokumentazzjoni kif ukoll il-ħtigijiet nazzjonali sabiex in-numru ta' applikazzjonijiet eliġibbli għal-finanzjament jiżdied.

Il-Programmi ta' Kooperazzjoni Territorjali Ewropea huma intiżi biex jinkoraġġixxu reġjuni u bliet minn pajjiżi membri tal-Unjoni Ewropea biex jaħdmu flimkien u jitgħallmu minghand xulxin permezz ta' programmi kongunti, proġetti u *networks*. Uffiċjali mid-Divizjoni għall-Ippjanar u Koordinazzjoni tal-Prioritajiet, taw prezentazzjonijiet dettaljati dwar dawn il-Programmi u spjegaw lill-parteciċipanti x'possibilitajiet jeżistu għall-kunsilli lokali biex jidhlu għal proġetti taħt dawn il-programmi.

Il-proġetti taħt il-kappa tal-Programmi ta' Kooperazzjoni Territorjali Ewropea huma ffinanzjati b' 85% tithallas mill-Fondi Strutturali waqt li 1-15% l-oħra tal-ispiza tithallas mill-kunsill lokali.

Maria Schembri, responsabbli mit-Taqsima tal-Fondi tal-MEUSAC tat għajnuniet prattiċi dwar kif il-kunsilli lokali jistgħu japplikaw għal proġetti taħt il-Programmi ta' Kooperazzjoni Territorjali Ewropea.

Il-parteciċipanti kellhom l-opportunità jisimgħu esperjenzi ta' kunsilli lokali li bbenefikaw minn fondi tal-Unjoni Ewropea u li għamlu proġetti li hallew riżultati tangibbli. Fost dawn kien hemm il-**Kunsill Lokali tal-Mosta permezz tal-proġett *Cultexchange***, li flimkien ma' msieħba minn Sqallija, niedew proġett għar-restawr ta' żewġ katakombi Paleo-Kristjani fil-lokalità tagħhom; il-**proġett *Medcypre* mill-Kunsill Lokali tal-Imġarr** li twettaq flimkien ma' ħmistax-il imsieħeb ieħor minn pajjiżi madwar l-Unjoni Ewropea biex jithawlu 2500 sigra taċ-ċipress f'żewġ lokalitajiet differenti fl-Imġarr, kif ukoll studju tal-kundizzjoni tal-art li fiha ġew imħawla dawn is-siġar; il-**proġett CSM/Emedit mill-Kunsill Lokali ta' Bormla**, li nġhaqad ma' msieħba minn pajjiżi membri oħra biex flimkien jirreklamaw ċentri żgħar storiċi, il-prodotti u t-tradizzjonijiet partikolari tagħhom; u il-**proġett *Medcoasnet Project* mill-Kunsill Lokali tal-Birgu u l-Fondazzjoni Temi Zammit**, flimkien ma' msieħba oħra minn pajjiżi Ewropej, li holqu netwerk permanenti ta' awtoritajiet u aġenziji nvoluti fl-immaniġġjar sostenibbli ta' żoni urbani kostali fil-Mediterran.
